Regional Center of Excellence for Nutrition Rehabilitation Resource and Training has been established at AIIMS Bhopal to provide technical support to the efforts of State Government to combat severe acute malnutrition among children U5. Department of Paediatrics and Community and Family Medicine (CFM) are supporting National Health Mission (NHM) and DWCD for strengthening the Integrated Management of Acute Malnutrition programme which includes treatment and prevention interventions. In similar Lines Technical Support Unit for supporting Anemia Mukht Bharat and maternal nutrition Programme of Health department was also established in CFM department of AIIMS Bhopal. The Centre of Excellence (SCOE) and Technical Support unit has a key role in providing technical inputs to the guidelines, capacity building, knowledge management, technical and operational support to programme implementation, monitoring and feedback to state government, support review of programme and data management. Applications of eligible candidates are invited to for the following posts on a purely contractual basis (up till the duration of project) for the CSAM & AMB Project.

Purpose of the posts: Under the technical guidance of Dept of Community and Family Medicine (AIIMS Bhopal) and in collaboration with DWCD and NHM, provide technical and operational support to plan, implement and monitor integrated management of acute Malnutrition (IMAM)/Community-based management of Severe Acute Malnutrition (CSAM), Infant and young child feeding, HBNC-HBYC, MAA, Micronutrient supplementation (Vitamin A), Deworming, Maternal Nutrition and Anemia Mukht Bharat programme (AMB). AIIMS Bhopal as TSU is also supporting research and allied activities in 4 districts of Madhya Pradesh. Department of community and family medicine is providing intensive technical and operational support in 04 districts **Khandwa, Narmadapuram, Dhar, and Jhabua** of Madhya Pradesh under the umbrella of CSAM & AMB programme. Technical oversight and funding for the position shall be provided by a respected, International Development Agency that works across the globe, to promote children's survival, protection and development. The advertised posts are for the conduct of field activities regarding the IMAM, MN, IYCF programmes & AMB programme.

Sr.No 1: Block Field Monitors (No of posts: 02 – Khandwa 01 and Narmadapuram - 01)

Block Field Monitors will be responsible for the overall implementation of CSAM (prevention and management), Maternal Nutrition, IYCF programmes & AMB programme activities. This will include identification and conducting anthropometric assessments of children with severe acute malnutrition (SAM) at different time points, conducting interviews with caregivers, coordinating with frontline health and nutrition workers for keeping records of enrolled children, building of capacities of field functionaries, monitoring of preventive programmes, home visits for programme validation, ensuring the quality of data collection and other additional work assigned by Principal Investigator/ Co-PI of the program from the state.

Major Duties and Responsibilities (including but not limited to):

- Support strengthening of different preventive programmes like vitamin A supplementation, Deworming, Anemia Mukht Bharat, IYCF, HBNC, HBYC, MAA and Poshan 2.0 (CBE, THR, Hot cooked meal etc.)
- Facilitate planning and capacity development for CSAM in the assigned blocks in collaboration with DWCD and Dept of Health.
- Facilitate inter-departmental coordination, convergence, review and monthly meetings including data analysis on programme indicators at blocks/sectors (including hotspots) to strengthen implementation of Integrated Management of SAM in the blocks.
- Monitor CSAM training programs for supervisory cadre and frontline functionaries (AWW, ASHA, ANM) for implementation of CSAM (as per programme need).
- Monitors roll out of CSAM programme with specific focus on streamlining monthly screening of children, identification and enrolment of SAM in CMAM programme, appropriate referral to facilities including tracking of children, in the assigned blocks with special focus on hotspots.
- Establish linkages between Facility based (NRC's, SMTU's and SMART unit) and Community based management of SAM children.
- Documentation / developing progress reports and sharing of best practices/success stories in CSAM program at community.
- Data entry in the mobile phone-based app and ensure quality of data collection.
- Any other task delegated by the competent authority.

Duration	The project duration is from 01.01.2026 to 31.03.2026 . The successful candidate shall be issued an initial contract till 31 st March 2026, which will be extended based on performance, funds availability from the funding agency, and continuing requirement for the position in 2026.

1. **Selection Venue:** Department of Community and Family Medicine, 2nd Floor, Medical College Building, AIIMS Bhopal. **No TA/DA will be paid for attending the walk-in written / skill test.**
2. **Age Concession:** Age will be calculated in completed years on the date of the interview. Age relaxation is admissible in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates, Retrenched Government Employees, Departmental Candidates (including projects), and ex-servicemen in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time. Age concession to the extent of services rendered in the research projects will also be admissible for experienced and skilled persons.
3. The work/responsibilities assigned to you may be exclusive, so you are not allowed to work personally or in any other organization even before or after the duty hour without written consent of the organization.
